SUMMARY OF 2024-2025

Highlights:

- Youth Movement Project was a success in connecting with local resources and youth in need and being recognized by the community.
- It was a strong way of saying farewell to our community and focusing on our priority: The youth of our community.
- Our YMP Mentorship Program supported four youths in building their skills to support and help youth playing various sports.

Lowlights:

- Volunteers were a struggle to find and maintain for the YMP.
- No new Trustee joined the board.
- Volunteer fatigue.

FOCUSING ON THE YOUTH MOVEMENT PROJECT

- We returned to St Lawrence Academy, where a smaller gym and a close relationship with the school helped to focus on the youth and not the politics of school and community program interrelations.
- The program ran for 17 weeks, and we averaged 11.12 youth per session. This was a great success, as the numbers are consistent with previous years, and we had a smaller space for the program. Weather did not seem to impact our numbers.
- The program coordinator managed the Facebook account, which provided weekly information to parents in the community about the program and upcoming activities. In addition, he also managed the gym material, activities schedule, and guest coaches. The PC and a volunteer were trained in standard First Aid, CPR C, and AED to maintain safety for all in the gym.
